

Privacy Policy

SystemDevCorporate LLC registration number 301 LLC 2020 (hereinafter - SystemDevCorporate) is committed to protecting your personal information and developing technology to provide you with the most powerful and secure online trading experience. This privacy statement applies to all SystemDevCorporate websites and governs data collection and usage. By visiting, browsing and/or using this website, you agree to the data practices described in this statement and acknowledge that you have read, understood and agree to be bound by the terms, conditions and comments contained herein and agree to comply with all applicable laws and regulations.

Collecting your personal information

SystemDevCorporate collects personal information such as your email address, name, home or work address, and telephone number. SystemDevCorporate also collects anonymous demographic information that does not only concern you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, habits, interests and preferences. Also, SystemDevCorporate automatically collects information about your hardware and software that you have collected. This information may include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times, and web site addresses. This information is used by SystemDevCorporate to provide service, maintain quality of service and obtain general statistics about the use of the SystemDevCorporate website. Please be aware that if you directly disclose personal information or important personal data through Orbex public forums, this information may be collected and used by third parties. Note: SystemDevCorporate does not read your private correspondence online. SystemDevCorporate encourages you to review the privacy statements of web sites you choose to link to from SystemDevCorporate so that you can understand how those sites collect, use and share your information. SystemDevCorporate is not responsible for privacy statements or other content on websites outside of SystemDevCorporate and outside the SystemDevCorporate group of websites.

Use of your personal information

In such cases, your unique personal information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) will not be passed on to third parties. In addition, SystemDevCorporate may share data with reliable partners, which help us to perform statistical analysis, send you e-mail or paper, provide customer support or arrange delivery. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to SystemDevCorporate, and they are obliged to keep your information confidential. SystemDevCorporate does not use or disclose strictly personal information such as race, religion, political affiliation without your explicit consent. SystemDevCorporate tracks the websites and pages that our customers visit within SystemDevCorporate in order to determine which services are most popular with SystemDevCorporate. This data helps provide customized content and advertising within SystemDevCorporate to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular area. The SystemDevCorporate websites will only disclose your personal information without notice if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary: (a) follow the letter of the law or comply with court orders regarding SystemDevCorporate or the website, (b) protect SystemDevCorporate's rights or property, and (c) act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of SystemDevCorporate users or the public.

Using Cookies

The SystemDevCorporate website consists of "Cookies" to personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard drive by a web server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or transfer viruses to your computer. Cookies contain strictly individual information about you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that created the cookie for you. One of the main purposes of cookies is to provide you with a convenient function to save your time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the web server that you have returned to a specific web page. For example, if you have set up SystemDevCorporate pages or have registered with SystemDevCorporate or for certain services, the cookie helps SystemDevCorporate to restore your individual information on subsequent visits to the site. This simplifies the process of registering your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, etc., with SystemDevCorporate. Except as specifically stated in this Privacy Statement, we will not share your personal information with any third party without your free, express and specific consent, and in any case when collecting your personal information, we will notify you of the recipient or categories of recipients of such information. In addition, we will inform you in a timely manner if this information is to be disclosed to a third party for the first time. We may disclose aggregate information such as demographic information and our statistical analysis to third parties, including advertisers or other business partners. This aggregate information does not include your personal information.

Agents

We use the services of credit card processing companies for deposit and withdrawal operations from your personal account. These companies do not remember, transfer, store or use your personal information for any other purpose.

Modification of this Regulation

SystemDevCorporate will periodically update this Privacy Statement to reflect client and company feedback. SystemDevCorporate recommends that you review this Privacy Statement regularly to be aware of how SystemDevCorporate protects your information.
